NOTIFICATION

No. F. 5-112/2015-PT-I: Consequent upon promulgation of National Vocational and Technical Training Commission (Amendment) Act, 2021 vide gazette of Pakistan's notification No. 22(33)/2020-Legis dated 4th December 2021, it is hereby notified that following new Sections have been added in NAVTTC Act, 2011:-

“22. Repeal of National Training Ordinance, 1980 (IX of 1980).

2. Subsequently, National Training Ordinance, 1980 (IX of 1980) stand canceled / dissolved. While, Manpower Division's Notification dated 28th May 1977 and all other notifications and orders issued prior or subsequent related thereto stand rescinded. Accordingly all assets, rights, powers, authorities and privileges and all property, moveable and immovable, cash and bank balance, reserve funds, investments and all other interests and right in, or arising out of, such property and all debts., liabilities and obligations of whatever kind of the National Training Board and Bureau subsisting immediately before its dissolution are transferred and vest in the National Vocational and Technical Training Commission.

3. Moreover, all employees of the Bureau, notwithstanding anything contained in any law agreement, deed, document or other instruments, stand transferred to the Commission in accordance with the terms and conditions of service as applicable to them and no officer or other employee whose services are so transferred shall be entitled to any compensation because of such transfer. Provided that such employees shall, within ninety days from the date of commencement of NAVTTC (Amendment) Act 2021 exercise an irrevocable option either to continue on the existing terms and conditions as civil servants or to opt to the employment of the Commission.

4. Consequent upon promulgation of NAVTTC (Amendment) Act, 2021, all administrative, financial, operational and legal matters of NTB (merged) will be referred/reported to NAVTTC, Islamabad.
